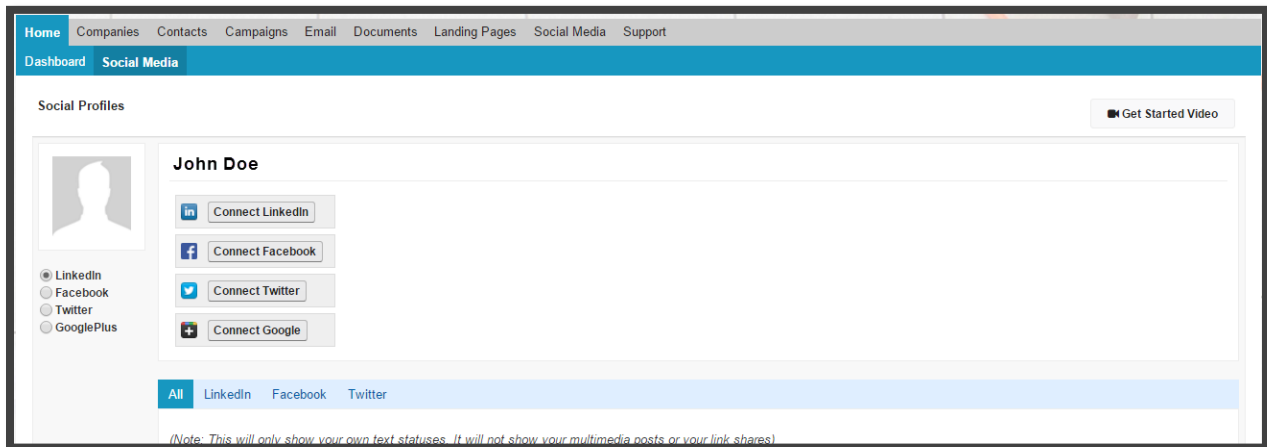
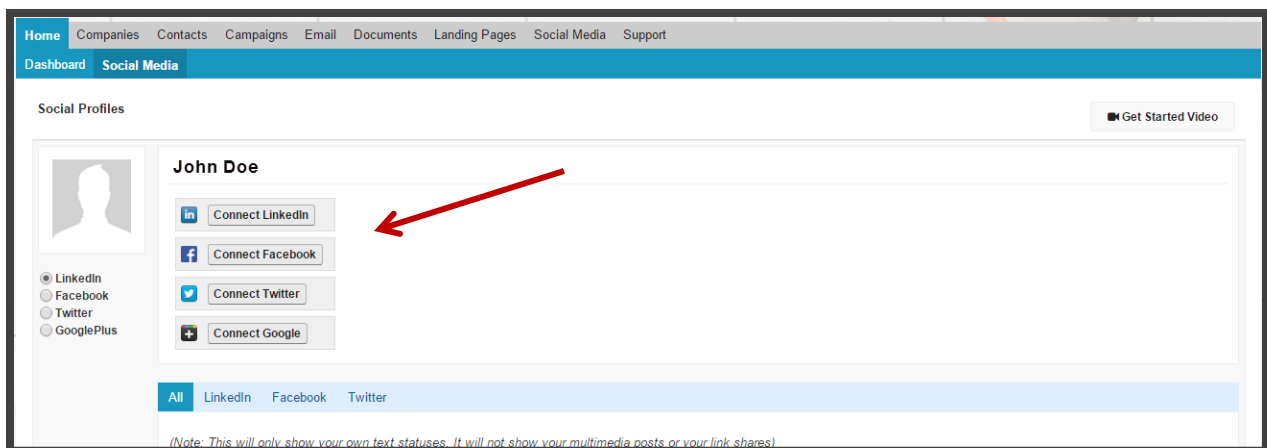


How To Connect Social Media

1) Log into MioDatos.

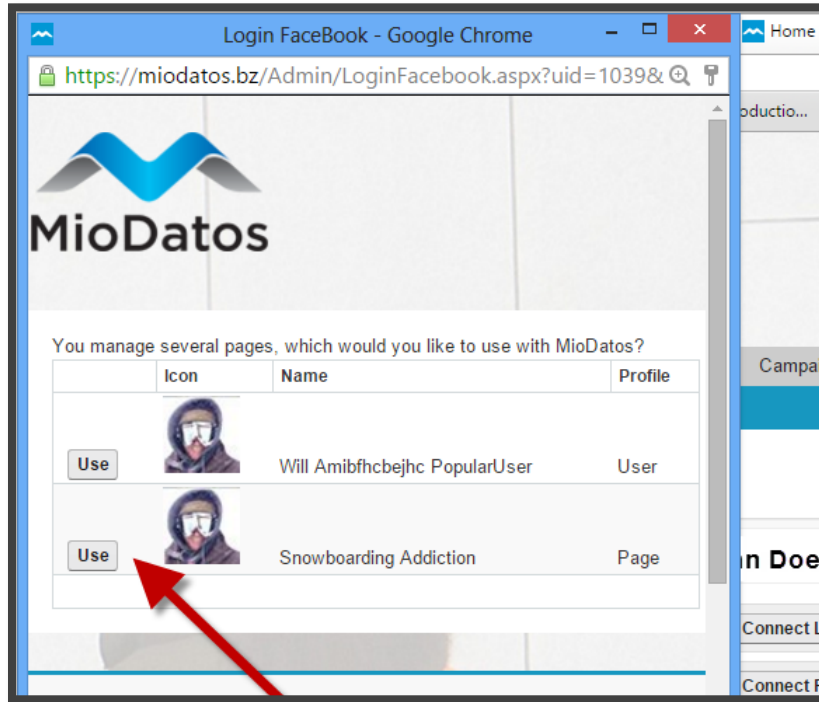


2) Click Connect (LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter, or Google) to connect each Social Media account.




- 3) After connecting each Social Media account, a popup window will appear requesting that you authorize MioDatos to have access. This authorization is required in order to run Social Media campaigns, as you need to grant MioDatos permission to post on your behalf.

Note: Facebook will allow you to connect to either your private profile or your business page. Whichever one you select is where your posts will be published with MioDatos. This can be changed by disconnecting your Facebook account and then reconnecting it.



- 4) Once all Social Media Accounts are connected, you will be able to view your Social Media streams with all posts that have been published through MioDatos.
